September 20, 2017 [War Room](#)

Tony and Elizabeth Jordan, a middle-class couple who seemingly have it all – but appearances can be deceiving. The Jordan's marriage has become a war zone and their daughter is collateral damage. With the help of Miss Clara, an older, wiser woman, Elizabeth discovers she can start fighting for her family instead of against them.

October 18, 2017 [The Courageous Heart of Irena Sendler](#)

Irena Sendler is a social worker in wartime Warsaw who proposes saving Jewish children from the Warsaw Ghetto but her idea is met with skepticism by fellow workers, her parish priest, and even her own mother Janina.

November 15, 2017 [Amazing Grace](#)

This is the inspiring story of how one man's passion and perseverance changed the world. William Wilberforce takes up the follows his courageous quest to end the British slave trade meeting intense opposition, but his minister, John Newton, urges him to see the cause through.

December 20, 2017 [The Christmas Candle](#)

Deep in the heart of the English countryside lies the enchanting village of Gladbury. Legend has it that every 25 years an angel visits the village candlemaker and touches a single candle. Whoever lights this candle receives a miracle on Christmas Eve. But in 1890, at the dawn of the electric age, this centuries-old legend may come to an end.

January 17, 2018 [A Time for Miracles](#)

A true story about Elizabeth Bayley Seton, the first American to ever be canonized. She took up Catholicism after the death of her rich husband, fought bigotry and opened free catholic schools and orphanages.

February 21, 2018 [Bakhita](#)

Born in a village in Sudan, kidnapped by slavers, often beaten and abused, and later sold to Federico Marin, a Venetian merchant, who brings her to Italy as nanny to Marin's daughter. She struggles with a new culture and at last comes to believe in Jesus but must fight for her freedom to become a nun.

March 21, 2018 [Bella](#)

An international soccer star (Eduardo Verastegui) is on his way to sign a multimillion dollar contract when something happens that brings his career to an abrupt end. A beautiful waitress (Tammy Blanchard), struggling to make it in New York City, discovers something about herself that she's unprepared for. In one irreversible moment, their lives are turned upside down...

April 18, 2018 [The Final Inquiry](#)

In 35 A.D., a Roman tribune is sent to Palestine to investigate the death and possible resurrection of a certain Jesus from Nazareth.

May 16, 2018 [The 13th Day: The True Story of Fatima](#)

In a world torn apart by persecution, war and oppression, 3 children were chosen to offer a message of hope to the world. Based on the memoirs of the oldest Seer, Lucia Santos, and many independent eye-witness accounts, The film dramatizes the *true* story of three young shepherds visited by a "Lady from Heaven."

June 20, 2018 [Finding St. Anthony](#)

This film reveals the journey of Fernando (whom we know today as Saint Anthony) and we discover a young man who was often "lost" and searching for direction; he wanted to make a difference in his world. As we encounter his humanity, we find someone we can relate to, someone who struggled, someone we could have easily called a friend.
